

UNNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Buffalo met at the Harding County Memorial Recreation Center at 6:00PM on January 12, 2026. Trustees present: John Klempel, Doris Dagman, Brandon Schleuning, Jason Lindholm, Tex Lermeny. Employee's present: Jaylene Stirling, Alvin Ruona. Guests present: Shayne Ruona.

President Klempel called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

Schleuning made a motion to approve the agenda, Lindholm seconded. All approved – motion carried.

GARBAGE PICK UP: Lindholm explained that he didn't agree with posting on Facebook to advertise there was trash pickup services, even not putting the name should not have been done, he mentioned as a private business we don't need to get business for him. Lindholm would like whoever is hauling trash to get a list and bring it to the town and then Stirling can tell him if those people are verified. Dagman is concerned about trusting him to get a list as she doesn't trust anyone and the Town has had problems in the past doing it this way. Discussion on how to verify customers was held. It was decided that whoever is hauling trash needs to get a list together and take it to the Town Office where the Finance Office will verify that those customers have accounts each week. The office should have nothing to do with trash pickup outside of this. Dagman asked to add that garbage must be covered if not bagged on number 7 of the Trash Hauler Requirements. Discussion with Ruona was held and he will be stopping each Monday to get a no dump list and verify customers.

MISC: Discussion was held on how things are going at the dump with Alvin.
