

ORDINANCE NO. 146

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF BUFFALO:

A: Scheme. Buildings on the east side of any street or avenue shall be given even numbers, and buildings on the west side thereof shall be given odd numbers. Buildings on the north side of any street or avenue shall be given even numbers and buildings on the south side shall be given odd numbers.

B: Size of the Lettering. Figures placed on any building or curb shall be at least three inches high, showing the number of the building and legible upon viewing from the street or avenue.

C: Property Owners Responsibility. It shall be the duty of the owner or agent having control of any house or building to have such house or building properly numbered as provided for in this ordinance, the correct number to be obtained from the Town of Buffalo or its designated representative. In case any house or building is incorrectly numbered, the Town of Buffalo or its designated representative may order the owner or agent thereof to correctly number the same and it is unlawful for such owner or agent to refuse to comply with such order. The number of any structure hereafter erected, as determined by the Town of Buffalo or its designated representative, may be indicated on the building permit.

D: Penalty. A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200.00 for each offense.
